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HORMONE SUPPLEMENTATION: RX OR SELL IN THE OFFICE??

At this time each physician must survey his/her resources for hormone supplements.

Practically every community now has some compounding pharmacies who will make various hormone preparations: creams, troches, sublingual, nasal, capsule.

For example, I have a local compounding pharmacy who will make sublingual solutions for HCG, oxytocin, pregnenolone, DHEA, and progesterone for me.

I have a second local pharmacy who will make me topical creams with testosterone (1 to 10%), estradiol, and progesterone for me.
